

## Active X Workaround By: Collin Quiring

This document is to demonstrate how to use the "Export to Excel" functions from Microsoft Project when the Active X controls are disabled.

It isn't difficult, but there are a few steps that need to be done in order.

<u>First</u>, open Notepad on your computer. Leave it empty. (This is because sometimes if you open it later, you have to repeat steps two and three below.)

**Second**, select "Yes" on the first option:




**Third**, select "OK" on the next box:



**Fourth**, open your notepad and paste in the data which will look almost totally unreadable. It should look something like this:



<u>Fifth</u>, save the file as whatever name you want with the "xml" extension. You may have to change the "save as file type" to "all files" for this to work.





<b>xth</b> , open Excel and then open the file that you just saved. Then, you should save the file as an "xls" e so that it re-formats it with Excel properties instead of the XML properties.
